

2016 Woodside High School PTSA Senior Scholarship



The Woodside PTSA will be awarding a minimum of two scholarships to the Woodside High School Class of 2017. Scholarship money can be used towards the purchase of college textbooks.

To be considered for a PTSA scholarship, the student:

- ✓ Must be a member of PTSA (membership is \$5; **JOIN NOW!!!**)
- ✓ Must be graduating from Woodside High School during the 2016-2017 school year
- ✓ Must have an acceptance letter to a two or four year college or university
- ✓ Must have a 2.5 GPA or greater (on the 4.0 grading scale)
- ✓ Must submit three letters of recommendation (example: guidance counselor, church, community organization, etc.)
- ✓ Must submit a 300 word essay about your career study choice and why you chose the college or university you are going to attend. The essay must be double spaced and 12 point font size.

Please submit your application information in a report folder labeled with your name, address, homeroom teacher's name, and "PTSA Scholarship Application" on the coversheet. The folder **must** include: verification of PTSA membership, copy of school acceptance letter, copy of unofficial transcript for *all* school years earning high school credits clearly stating current GPA (this can be obtained from the Guidance Office), three letters of recommendation, and a 300 word essay.

Extended submission deadline is Wednesday, May 5, 2017. Late or incomplete applications CANNOT be considered.*

Please turn your completed application folder in to the Main Office. Scholarships will be awarded at the Senior Class Awards Ceremony in May.
