The Woodside PTSA is offering 1 individual \$250.00 scholarships to a graduating Senior of the Woodside High School Class of 2012. Scholarship money will be used towards the purchase of college textbooks.

To be considered for a PTSA scholarship, the student:

- ✓ Must be a member of PTSA (Joined before January 1, 2012)
- ✓ Must be graduating from Woodside High School during the 2011 – 2012 school year
- ✓ Must have an acceptance letter to a two or four year college or university
- ✓ Must have a 2.5 GPA or greater (on the 4.0 grading scale)
- ✓ Must submit three letters of recommendation (example: guidance counselor, church, community organization, etc.)
- ✓ Must submit a 300 word essay about your career study choice and why you chose the college or university you are going to attend. The essay must be Ariel font, size 12, and double spaced.

Please submit your application information in a report folder labeled with your name, address, homeroom teacher's name, and "PTSA Scholarship Application" on the coversheet. The folder should include: *verification of PTSA membership, copy of school acceptance letter, copy of unofficial transcript that states current GPA (this can be obtained from the Guidance Office), three letters of recommendation, and 300 word essay.*
